

## Transportation

In the interest of making this Workshop environmentally friendly we will provide some limited bus transportation to and from the BC Ferries terminals in Nanaimo for those who do not wish to bring their vehicles to the Island. There will be two buses available to meet a specific ferry at each of the two Nanaimo terminals. This is a first come, first served opportunity. Please make sure you check the box on the registration form indicating that you are planning to use this service.

In Campbell River there will be buses available for transportation to and from accommodations and the venues.

### **Friday, May 20th**

There will be a bus (or buses) at the Departure Bay Terminal in Nanaimo approximately 2:30 pm to meet the 12:50 pm ferry from Horseshoe Bay. The buses will then go to the Duke Point Terminal to meet the 12:45 pm ferry from Tsawwassen before travelling to Campbell River, going directly to the North Island College (NIC) venue.

Buses will depart from NIC at 8:30 and 9:00 pm for accommodations

### **Saturday, May 21<sup>st</sup>**

Buses will pick up from accommodations starting at 7:30 am from Quinsam campground and follow attached route to NIC.

Buses pick up from NIC at 4:45 and 5:00 pm to return to accommodations.

Buses pick from accommodation at 5:45 and 6:00 pm and return to NIC

Buses return to accommodation at 9:30 and 10:00 pm.

### **Sunday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>**

Buses pick up from accommodations at 7:30 am for NIC

Field trip transportation will start from NIC at 9:00 am.



Return everyone to NIC to NIC by 2:00 pm.

Two buses will leave Campbell River at 3:00 pm for the 5:20 pm ferry from Departure Bay and then the 5:40 departure from Duke Point.

**Notes:**

- If you intend to walk on to the ferry and make use of the bus transportation to Campbell River please make sure this is indicated in your registration.
  - On long weekends even foot traffic on the ferries can be heavy – allow plenty of time to make your sailing.
  - The sailing times quoted are based on the published ferry schedule at the time of writing – confirm times closer to the sailing dates

- The registration package will include a pass for the municipal bus system provided by the City of Campbell River
